

## Session Highlights\*

The session of PFPC met on Wednesday, January 6, 2016 in the Madeline Carswell Room. Ten of twelve ruling elders were in attendance. The meeting adjourned at 8:53 p.m. Supper provided by Ellen Davis preceded the meeting.

Subjects discussed were:

- Meeting was called to order at 6:57 p.m. with prayer reflecting on Scripture, “Jesus also had been baptized and was praying.” Luke 3:21
- Approved the “Consent Agenda” for the evening. Approvals included:
  - Received and approved minutes from December 2, 2015 stated Session meeting;
  - Received and approved minutes from December 16, 2015 called Session meeting;
  - Received Pastor’s Report January 6, 2016;
  - Received 2015 Year’s End attendance report: 2015 was like 2010; was like 2006; was like 2005; all averaging about 100 people per Sunday
  - Approved serving Communion every month at N@N;
  - Approved adding to February Session Docket, “Decision time on BFF 2016 “;
  - Approved Seam McGinley to be a counter for Planning & Finance Committee;
- Commissioned the record at 232 members, unchanged from December
- Reviewed the PFPC Session Action Register – January 2016
- Received the PFPC Planning Calendar – January 2016
- Received the initial 2015 financial report from P&F. PFPC met its 2015 budget, which was approved by Session in 2014 with a deficit. In other words, the congregation overcame the deficit.
- Approved the presentation and distribution of Valentine bags for February, a long-time PFPC tradition.
- Approved the expenditure of \$200 toward the new “Learning Lab,” offering the opportunity for local public school students to access the Internet one night a week. The NK High School has provided Chrome® tablets but some students have no Internet access at home.
- Approved the Lion’s Club to conduct the Bland Competition in the PFPC sanctuary, a youth musical performance competition, on Thursday, February 18. This competition has been held in the sanctuary for many years.
- Meeting adjourned with prayers.
