

Session Highlights*

The PFPC Session met on Wednesday, August 2, 2017 in the Madeline Carswell Room of PFPC Educational Wing. Eleven of twelve ruling elders were in attendance. The meeting adjourned at 8:22 p.m. Supper provided by Ellen Davis preceded the meeting.

Subjects discussed were:

- Meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. with prayer reflecting on Scripture, “O Lord, you know me. You know when I sit and when I stand,” Psalm 139:2.
- Approved the “Consent Agenda” for the evening including:
 - Received and approved Session Minutes from July 5, 2017 stated meeting;
 - Received and approved Session Minutes from July 9, 2017 called meeting;
 - Approved New Member Sunday, October 9, 2017;
 - Received Pastor’s Report for August 2, 2017;
- Commissioned the record at 245 members;
- Reviewed the Action Register – August 2017 (all actions completed);
- Reviewed the Planning Calendar – August 2017, highlighting the PFPC Breakfast, on Sunday, September 10, between the worship services;
- Reviewed new PFPC policies for Child Protection & Sexual Misconduct, returning both to committee for further review with other committees impacted by the changes in procedure;
- Received report of Energy Audit on PTP and requested a written report to be submitted at September meeting;
- Reviewed renovations/repairs to PTP to be conducted by volunteers during August, while the property is vacant;
- Approved replacement of carpet in PTP, with a spending limit of \$1,500;
- Adjourned with prayer, including David Thompson, still hospitalized with protracted complications following surgery; Eve Van Dyke, suffering a fever; Aaron Evans, to go through stem cell treatment; 6 year old Mackensie, to be examined by a neurologist through MRI, and others on our hearts. We also gave thanks for Jerry Sprouse’s recovery and return and Evan Van Dyke’s progress at work.
