The PFPC Session met on Wednesday, May 2, 2018 in the Madeline Carswell Room of PFPC Educational Wing. Eight of eleven elders were in attendance. The meeting adjourned at 8:24 p.m. Supper provided by Jim (& Kaye) Aguirre preceded the meeting.

Subjects discussed were:

- Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with prayer reflecting on Scripture, “You did not choose me but I chose you.” John 15:16 (NRSV)
- Approved the “Consent Agenda” for the evening including:
 - Received and approved Session Minutes from March 7, 2018 stated meeting;
 - Received Pastor’s Report for May 2, 2018;
 - Approved pastor to officiate the Buckheit-VanderPloeg Christian wedding, Saturday, May 12, 2018, at Westover Plantation;
- Commissioned the record at 251 members;
- Reviewed the Action Register – May 2018 (3 of 4 actions completed);
- Reviewed the Planning Calendar – May 2018;
- Approved Women’s Bible Study curriculum: Fasting;
- Approved C.E. Committee to decorate the Sanctuary before worship on Sunday, July 8, for VBS: Shipwrecked;

- Approved the fourth draft of the PFPC Children and Youth Protection Policy;
- Approved the first draft of the PFPC Position Description Substitute Musician;
- Approved offering aged youth Sunday School chairs to congregation on Sundays, 3/11 & 18, before disposal;
- Approved pastor proceeding to organize an PFPC Evening of Music, a Sunday evening, the first featuring Christian singer/songwriter, Paula Creamer;
- Approved gathering of VBS volunteers for a training and work session, immediately following 11 am worship service, June 10, lunch provided, 2 hours;
- Approved Jim Aguirre to seek volunteers from the congregation for a New Kent County project of Habitat for Humanity;
- Approved Buildings & Grounds to immediately conduct an Energy Audit of the PTP property;
- Adjourned with prayer including: the local family of Deborah Coleman, blues singer; Trey Davis (Lasik surgery); Ralph Holloman (surgery to repair aneurism); Edna Christian (cancer);
