

## **Youth and Young Adults Committee Responsibilities**

### **Mission Statement:**

The Youth and Young Adult Committee oversees the education and service projects of the youth of PFPC, as well as overseeing and implementing the programs for the young adults of the church to foster relationships and community.

### **Responsibilities:**

1. To oversee the ministry of the youth and their families, including recruiting and supporting program leaders, helping youth leaders obtain the necessary materials and funds for the programs, and recognizing graduating high school seniors in worship;
2. To coordinate and support annual activities for youth and young adults, such as Youth Sunday, Richmond Friends of the Homeless, and Bible studies;
3. To promote youth and young adult programs of the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly;
4. To communicate components of the Youth and Young Adults Program to the congregation and the Session;
5. To oversee (by the Chair) the adherence to the applicable requirements of the Children and Youth Protection Policy;
6. To assist the Pastor in planning for Young Adult Bible studies, as needed;
7. Committee Chair (appointed by session) will contact all volunteers (as provided by the Stewardship Committee from the annual Stewardship Campaign) and welcome them to serve on the committee. If the committee is not available to new members, that information should be provided to the Chair of the Stewardship Committee so that such committee is not listed as an option on the Annual Stewardship Pledge Card;
8. Committee Chair (or designee) will maintain a roster of active members on the committee and will provide the roster to the Web Team for inclusion on the PFPC.org web site by February of each year. Chair will work with the Policy and Personnel Committee to develop a synopsis of the committee's duties to include on the PFPC web site.
