

Session Notes*

The session of PFPC met on Wednesday, April 1, 2015 in the Madeline Carswell room of the Educational Wing. All twelve ruling elders were in attendance. The meeting adjourned at 8:45 p.m. Supper provided by Jerry Sprouse preceded the meeting.

Subjects discussed were:

- Meeting was called to order at 6:52 p.m. with prayer reflecting on the Scripture, “Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom. (Jesus) replied, “Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in Paradise.” Luke 23:42-43 (NRSV)
- Welcomed and gave privilege of the floor to H. Carson Rhyne, Jr., General Presbyter and Stated Clerk of Presbytery of the James. His visit was a follow-up to the presbytery meeting on March 7th.
- Approved the “Consent Agenda” for the evening with no withdrawals. Approvals included: approval of minutes from March 4th stated session meeting; received Pastor’s Report April 1, 2015; received \$1,300 from Youth Yard Sale; approved curriculum for Friday Morning Bible Study; approved call for volunteers for VBS, SonSparks Labs, July 12-16, 2015.
- Commissioned the record at 230 members, a loss of one member by transfer since February.
- Reviewed the 2015 Action Register.
- Approved \$7,500 for a Phase 1 feasibility & demographics study of a PTP nursery school.
- Tasked Planning & Finance to follow-up on church insurance through Brotherhood Mutual, through Sanford Agency in Richmond.
- Approved Girl Scouts to plant a small rose garden at the entrance of the Educational Wing in the space between the ramp and sidewalk. Additionally approved Girl Scouts to place a box in the parlor to collect peanut butter for the local food bank.
- Received initial 2014 Financial Review, with the church in good standing. A written report is to be received in May.
- Approved of Fellowship Committee using 10 tables from the church for the Easter Sunrise Service at Janette & Howard Gammon’s home. Tables will be returned Easter Sunday.
- Meeting adjourned with prayer including concerns for Jim Baker and deep brain surgery to halt tremors, Larry Chotiner and his 6 month old granddaughter diagnosed with tumors on spine and brain, and others.
