

Session Highlights*

The PFPC Session met on Wednesday, December 5, 2018 at Wallace Manor. Eleven of twelve elders were in attendance. The meeting adjourned at 7:59 p.m. Supper provided by Pastor Steve preceded the meeting.

Subjects discussed were:

- Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with prayer reflecting on Scripture, The Parable of the Talents, “For it is as if a man, going on a journey, summoned his slaves and entrusted his property to them.” Matthew 25:14 (NRSV) Elders have been entrusted with God’s property and challenged through the parable to take risks with that property.
- Approved the “Consent Agenda” for the evening including:
 - Received and approved Session Minutes from November 7, 2018 stated meeting;
 - Received and approved Session Minutes from November 18, 2018 called meeting;
 - Received Pastor’s Report for December 5, 2018;
- Commissioned the record at 251 members (unchanged);
- Reviewed the Action Register – December 5, 2018;
- Reviewed the Planning Calendar – December 2018;
- Approved Scout Troup 518 to use PTP on Sunday, December 9, for one hour as a staging area, like SNS, for the Christmas Parade that afternoon;
- Received report from Good Samaritan committee that all 16 names have been taken by our church to be gifted on December 9, participating with the 2018 Give a Child a Christmas, Matthew’s Haven;
- Approved 2019 Annual Congregational meeting to be held on Sunday, January 27, immediately following the 11 am worship service to receive the State of the Church and vote on pastor’s Terms of Call;
- Approved 2019 Committee assignments;
- Elected their 2019 Clerk of Session, Leigh Quick;
- Celebrated the terms of outgoing Ruling Elders Ellen Davis, Paul Davis, and Ed Batkins;
- Adjourned with prayer including a number of Cares & Concerns: Karen; Lil; and Elaine;
