

## Session Highlights\*

The PFPC Session met on Wednesday, January 9, 2019 at PFPC. All elders were in attendance. The meeting adjourned at 9:17 p.m. Supper provided by Pete Adamson preceded the meeting.

Subjects discussed were:

- Reviewed the Action Register – January 9, 2019;
- Reviewed and Accepted the Planning Calendar – 2019;

- Approved VBS curriculum for 2019, Roar: Life is wild; God is good (Group’s Easy VBS);
