The PFPC Session met on Wednesday, February 6, 2019 at PFPC. Eleven of twelve elders were in attendance. The meeting adjourned at 9:28 p.m. Supper provided by Leigh Quick preceded the meeting.

Subjects discussed were:

- Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with prayer
- Received a monthly lesson: Is this your responsibility? Topic: Coordinating Events
- Approved the “Consent Agenda” for the evening including:
 - Received and approved Session Minutes from January 9, 2019 stated meeting;
 - Received and approved Congregational Minutes from January 27, 2019 annual meeting;
 - Received Pastor’s Report for February 6, 2019;
 - Approved pastor’s out-of-state pastoral care visit in February;
 - Approved pastor’s time on 2019 mission trip as time at work;
 - Approved pastor to lead worship at Olivet Homecoming as well as the baptism of Emaline Hope Wallace, daughter of Edwin and Emily Anne Wallace;
 - Approved pastor’s Vacation & Study Leave schedule for 2019;
- Commissioned the record at 251 members (unchanged);
- Reviewed the Action Register – February 6, 2019;
- Reviewed and Accepted modifications to the Planning Calendar – 2019;
- Approved Certificate of Transfer of Sandy Breeden to Tikvat Israel Messianic Synagogue, Richmond, VA;
- Received report on Souper Bowl of Caring: collected 250 lb. of food, and \$615 in donations, to be given to Proclaiming Grace Outreach, Barhamsville, VA;
- Approved additional expenses to complete HVAC repairs to the PTP house;
- Approved seeking rental agent for PTP property, in preparation for potential tenant;
- Approved replacing “Tot Boxes” in sanctuary with “Youth Satchels;”
- Reviewed Sexual Misconduct Policy; Attendance Policy; and Session Covenant;
- Approved Stewardship chairperson to attend POJ stewardship event on Feb. 26th;
- Elected Leigh Quick to be commissioner to the February 16, 2019 presbytery meeting, Three Chopt Presbyterian Church (Ayars Lore was elected at January meeting);
- Tasked session to continue review of all committees to reduce the total number of committees from 13 to 11, returning to the March stated meeting with suggestions;
- Investigate archival of session’s ancient minutes with Presbyterian Historical Society, Philadelphia, to halt the deterioration of these valuable records;
- Adjourned with prayer including a number of Cares & Concerns;
