- Approved church to participate in the New Kent County Fair, August 17 & 18;
- Approved discontinuing participation Richmond Friends of the Homeless as of the August 4, 2019;
- Approved participation in New Kent County Public Schools, “Otter Power Packs,” beginning September 2019;
- Adjourned with prayer including a number of Cares & Concerns;
