The PFPC Session met on Wednesday, July 24, 2019 at PFPC. Ten of twelve elders were in attendance. The meeting adjourned at 8:59 p.m. Supper provided by Mary-Catherine Sheridan preceded the meeting.

Subjects discussed were:

- Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with prayer
- Received a monthly lesson: Is this your responsibility? Topic: Incoming class of elders
- Approved the “Consent Agenda” for the evening including:
 - Received and approved Session Minutes from June 5, 2019 stated meeting;
 - Received Pastor’s Report for July 24, 2019;
 - Approved pastor to officiate Susan “Rocket” Johnson Memorial Service at Ocala, FL, on Monday, July 29;
 - Approved Jonathan McBee and Peg Shaw-McBee to perform at Nexus @ Night, Wednesday, July 31;
- Commissioned the record at 202 members (reduced due to the death of three members);
- Reviewed the Action Register – July 24, 2019;
- Reviewed the Planning Calendar – July 24, 2019;
- Received report from Youth & Young Adult on a very successful 2019 VBS, “Roar: Life is Wild; God is Good,” and introduced the likely 2020 VBS curriculum, “Rocky Railway: Jesus’ Power Pulls Us Through;
- Tasked Buildings & Grounds to write a fire escape plan for the second floor classrooms;

- Nominating Committee revealed the incoming slate of ruling elders to be elected by the congregation on Sunday, August 11, during the 11 am worship service, as the incoming Class of 2020: Johanna Davis; Ruth Hopke; Nathan Richards; Jim Wallace;
- Approved congregational meeting to elect the ruling elders of incoming Class of 2022;
