

### Session Highlights\*

The PFPC Session met on Wednesday, March 4, 2020, at PFPC. All Elders were in attendance. The meeting adjourned at 9:53 p.m. Supper provided by Nathan Richards preceded the meeting.

Subjects discussed were:

- Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with prayer, led by substitute moderator Rev. Andy Meyers;
- Approved the Consent Agenda for the evening: received and approved Session Minutes from the February 5, 2020, stated session meeting and the February 16, 2020, annual congregational meeting;
- Heard a report from Treasurer Paul Robinson about our insurance policies;
- Heard a report from the Interim Pastor Search Committee (Ayars Lore – chair, Jeff Ludwig, Laura Richards, and Jane VanDyke) by chair -

Following training by Rev. Holbrook, General Presbyter of the Presbytery of the James, the committee has met several times and developed a Minister Information Form (MIF), which provides information about PFPC and its needs. A great deal of this information was from our recent *Feast for All* survey results. The MIF was presented to Session last night. After much discussion, Session decided upon the number of hours we wanted the interim pastor to work per week and the salary range we could afford. After this form is approved by Rev. Holbrook, it will be posted to the Church Leadership Connection web site of PC-USA. The Committee will be reviewing Pastor Information Forms, which are similar to resumes, conducting interviews, review sermons and then making a recommendation to Session of the person that they feel would be the best fit for PFPC. Upon approval of Session, this person would then become our interim pastor. (Note: An interim pastor is a short-term [9-12 months] position and he / she, in nearly all cases, is not allowed to become the new pastor. He / She has been trained to help in the healing of a church and preparing the congregation for a new pastor.);

- Commissioned the record at 145;
- Reviewed the planning calendar;
- Received the treasurer's report;
- Heard reports and future plans from six committees;
- The Men's Work Week will begin March 9<sup>th</sup> and will include repairs and "sprucing up" of PFPC and PTP;
- Adjourned with prayer including a number of cares and concerns.

The next stated meeting of Session is on Wednesday, April 1, 2020, at PFPC. Supper will be provided by Ayars Lore at 6:30 p.m.
