

Session Highlights

The PFPC Session met on Wednesday, May 5, 2021, in the fellowship hall at PFPC and via Zoom. Ten elders and Rev. Coleman participated.

The meeting was called to order with a devotional and prayer, led by Rev. Coleman.

Subjects discussed were:

- Approval of the minutes of the April 7, 2021 meeting;
- Receiving of the Pastor's Report from Rev. Coleman and approval for her to be out of the office from May 14-26;
- Approval of motion brought by Elder Robinson to resume adult Sunday School on June 6;
- Update from Elder Hopke that applications for the Administrative Assistant position are being received, and interviews are being scheduled;
- Approval of recommendations presented by Elder Gammon on behalf of the Covid Task force;
- Reminder by Clerk Quick of continued need for cleaners following Sunday worship;
- Naming of the Mission Study Team who will be commissioned on Sunday, May 9 during morning worship;
- Sharing by Elder Lore of work being completed around the church building and PTP property and of need for volunteers to paint, do electrical work, and complete other tasks at PTP property;
- Sharing by Elder Christian that the Worship, Stewardship and Fellowship Committees will continue to work together to establish a way to honor and recognize the members of the congregation who have died in the last year since Covid began;
- Recognition of increased giving in April as noted by Elder Richards' written financial report (YTD giving is still below budgeted net income);
- Adjourned with prayer.
