

Session Highlights – March 2022

- Accepted the final report from the ad hoc Pocahontas Trail Property (PTP) Committee and approved the recommendations made by the committee. The report will be discussed at a called congregational meeting following the Sunday morning Worship Service on March 20th. - Accepted the resignation of Elder Shannon Richard.
- Confirmed Easter Sunrise Service will be held at the home of Janette Gammon on April 17th at 7:00am. Limited food and beverage service will be provided. More details to follow.
- Amended the PFPC COVID Policy to make wearing of masks optional during Sunday morning Worship Services.
- Accepted the completed Ministry Information Form (MIF) from the Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC). The MIF is the church's resume that is distributed to potential pastor candidates.
- Approved Bonnie Daniel as the Fund-Raising Treasurer for the parlor renovation project.
- Received a report from the Buildings and Grounds Committee which included recognition of Ruth Hopke for her role in procuring the new signs on the roadways leading to the church and identified Chris Christian and the project lead for the church clean-up team.
- Approved a recommendation from the Christian Education Committee to conduct Vacation Bible School on July 17th – July 21st from 6:00pm-8:30pm.
- Approved a recommendation from the Fellowship Committee to conduct an Easter Egg Hunt on the church grounds. More details to follow.
- Approved a motion to resume traditional communion on April 6th.
