

## **Session Highlights – August 2022**

- Received a summary from Rev. Cindy Kissel-Ito regarding the small group meetings held in July. Cindy Reported that there were common themes among all groups, which will likely influence PFPC programming throughout the fall and winter, at a minimum.
- Approved a motion to immediately focus session's efforts on youth, intergenerational relationship building, and exploration of virtual Worship Service options, while tabling action on offering a second Worship Service until spring 2023.
