

## Session Highlights – October 9, 2022

- Received a report from Pete Adamson and Martha Martin Daugherty, members of the Pastor Nominating Committee.
- Received an update from Elder Ginny Adamson Taylor regarding the presentation to be delivered to the congregation regarding the session restructuring.
- Approved PFPC's participation in the ***Give a Child a Christmas*** program.
- Approved recommendations from the Worship Committee regarding Elders on Duty, which includes having two Elders on Duty each Sunday.
- Approved a proposal to offer Poinsettias for sale.
- Received a report from Planning and Finance Chair, Nathan Richards, that the on-line donation platform, ***Easy Tithe***, generates more donations for PFPC than in-person giving. Elder Richards also stated that the 2023 budget will be very dependent on the level of donations compared to the planned salary of a new pastor. The session is expected to further refine the budget in November and approve a budget in December.
- Approved Elder Taylor as the PFPC Commissioner to the October 15<sup>th</sup> Presbytery of the James meeting.
