

Session Highlights – December 4, 2022

- Approved the 2023 PFPC operating budget.
- Discussed updates to the PFPC Ministry Information Form (MIF), which serves as the church's resume used in the search for a new full-time pastor.
- Approved an extension of the covenant agreement (contract) with the Rev. Cindy Kissel-Ito through August 2023.
- Reviewed and approved changes to the PFPC Bylaws, which relate to restructuring of session. The congregation will vote on the proposed changes at the January 29th congregational meeting.
- Elected Paul Robinson as the PFPC Treasurer for 2023.
- Elected Ginny Adamson Taylor as the Clerk of Session for 2023.
- Received reports from the Administrative, Christian Life, and Community and Mission Pillars (formerly committees).
- Rescheduled February session meeting to February 5th.
