

2023 Annual Congregational Meeting: **Proposed Bylaw Changes**

Current Bylaws #4, 8

4. The Session shall consist of 12 members in three nearly equal classes. Elders are to be nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the Congregation. Terms of Office shall ordinarily be one, three-year term. Youth elders (25 years of age and under) may serve terms of one, two or three years (per Book of Order G-14.0201a) as negotiated by the Nominating Committee under guidance of the Session. Elders may serve no more than six consecutive years after which an elder must rotate off the Session for at least one year.

8. A Quorum of the Session shall be the moderator and at least one half of the elders in active service on the Session. A Quorum of the Session for receiving new members shall be the moderator and at least three members of the Session.

Proposed Bylaw Changes #4,8

4. The Session shall consist of **12 members rotating in three nearly equal classes**. Elders are to be nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the Congregation. Terms of Office shall ordinarily be one, three-year term. Youth elders (25 years of age and under) may serve terms of one, two or three years (per *Book of Order* G-14.0201a) as negotiated by the Nominating Committee under guidance of the Session. Elders may serve no more than six consecutive years after which an elder must rotate off the Session for at least one year.

8. A Quorum of the Session shall be the moderator and at least one half of the elders in active service on the Session. A Quorum of the Session for receiving new members shall be the moderator and at least **three** members of the Session.
